PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

Let's meet at my house Sunday before the game! --- GOD

As we prepare for the months of November and December it is fitting, I think that we pause once again to think about our relationship with God. Here's what we are reminded of in Hebrews: "Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another – and all the more as you see the Day approaching. (Hebrews 10:25)

To have a close, rewarding relationship with God, you don't have to be perfect. But there is one requirement: You must be genuinely committed to the relationship. That includes spending some time getting to know God and God's family.

Just as a person can't be "mostly married" or "somewhat pregnant," you cannot have a casual acquaintance with God. A relationship with the all-living, all-powerful Creator of the universe just doesn't work that way. And part of building a meaningful relationship with God is spending time at God's house with God's people, the Church. 


