

Shoe Ministry

Immanuel supports the shoe ministry that was started by "Ralph the Shoe Guy" owner of Discount Shoe Repair in downtown Syracuse. Ralph refurbishes the shoes which may involve some polish or replacing the laces or putting on new soles and then he gives the shoes to the Rescue Mission. Ralph started this ministry in 2010 with a donation of 65 pairs of shoes and it has grown to 37,370 pairs of shoes in 2021! Ralph donates his time and the supplies, however he also accepts cash to help defray the cost of the supplies. Immanuel donated 89 pairs of shoes in 2021. Let's continue to help Ralph and the Rescue Mission! The donation box is in the Narthex under the coat hangers.
